What we do

Couple Support Group

The CBCM serves as a support group to the existing members who await to be blessed with their own children, as well as incoming members who are on the same journey.

Handog Kinabukasan Program

This is a scholarship program that aims to provide educational support to selected students from different levels in the Aeta Resettlement and Rehabilitation in Subic, Zambales.

Marriage Encounter (ME) Seminars

ME Seminars are conducted for couples in unique situations (e.g. childless couples, drug rehab patients) that aim to strengthen their relationship with each other and with God.

Establishment of Learning Resource Center

CBCM are pursuing efforts in line with rehabilitation of the library in the Aeta Resettlement and Rehabilitation Site in Subic, Zambales into a Learning Resource Center where educational materials will be provided for the children.

Mission Works

Outreach activities such as gift giving, medical mission, feeding activity and the likes are being undertaken to extend help and generosity to underprivilege communities.

Bible Study, Pilgrimage, Recollection

As part of its goal to enrich the spiritual life and build camaraderie among its members, the CBCM is holding regular bible study sessions, pilgrimages and recollections for its members.

Spiritual, Emotional and Wellness Seminars

Seminars are facilitated to strengthen the spiritual, emotional and health of childless couples and make them feel that they are not alone in this journey.
